
### Getting to Cervia

**By car**: take the A14 motorway leading from Bologna to Rimini, exit at Cesena Nord, take the E45 toward Ravenna, exit at CASEMURATE (approx.  $7~\rm km$ ), then follow signs to Cervia: approx.  $15~\rm km$ 

**<u>By train</u>**: be advised that the station is named *Cervia-Milano Marittima*. Departing from Bologna, either catch a direct connection to Cervia-Milano Marittima, or ride a train to Rimini, then from Rimini to Cervia (for schedules see <a href="www.trenitalia.it">www.trenitalia.it</a>)

**By air**: Bologna international airport (BLQ) is located 90 km from Cervia. Direct flights to many European cities, or else through Milan or Rome. From BLQ there are convenient services to Cervia by several providers, costing approx. 25 € per person. The Workshop organization will be glad to help arranging said service for attendees requesting it. Please contact us at least a couple of days before arrival.

A bus will be provided on the afternoon of May 29th to take everybody interested to Cervia: you might want to visit Bologna then meet the bus in the location - close to the train station - that will be announced timely.
